UT³ Noyce Applicant Requirements

1. Baccalaureate degree in STEM (science, technology, engineering, or mathematics) area with a minimum 2.7 GPA
2. Be a U.S. citizen or national, or permanent resident alien
3. Transcripts reviewed by the Ohio Department of Education
4. Pass Praxis II in content area

UT³ Noyce Application Process

1. Send transcripts to Ohio Department of Education (ODE) for review of eligibility
2. Register for Praxis II - content test for the teaching field
Test score reports are to be sent directly to The University of Toledo, R1845. <http://www.ets.org>
3. Complete UT³ Noyce application documents and return to UT³ office by April 1
 - UT³ Noyce application form
 - Two typed essay responses
 - Two letters of recommendation
 - Official transcripts for degree(s)
 - Ohio Department of Education review of transcripts
 - Praxis II test score for content
 - Resume showing work experience
4. Review process
 - Committee reviews applications
 - Committee interviews prospective candidates
 - Committee recommends selected candidates to the Director
 - The Director reviews and awards the scholarship
5. Receive notification of acceptance into the UT³ Noyce program by the UT³ Noyce office
6. Apply to the College of Graduate Studies and the Judith Herb College of Education
